Sajid is currently organising the UK’s first ever constituency-wide “Parliamentary TeleForum”. This will allow constituents like you to take part, **completely free of charge**, in a direct telephone conference call with your local Member of Parliament.

Sajid is holding this first ever call on Wednesday 26th November between 7.00pm and 8.00pm.

All you will need to do to take part is indicate that you are happy to be telephoned by Sajid – by completing the short registration form online at www.vekeo.buzz/sajidjavid – and be available on the telephone number you have given us when Sajid rings.

There is absolutely no limit to the number of people on the call but **you must be one of Sajid’s constituents in order to take part.**

The call will not be a long recorded message. It will be a “live” interactive call with your local MP. During the call, you will be able to indicate your wish to ask a question via one of our call operators and you will be also be given the opportunity to vote by telephone keypad on a number of topics.

Alternatively, you can just settle back and simply listen to the call – the choice is yours!
